History

PAZIENZA was designed by Laurent Giles and built by Cantiere Navale V. Beltrami in Genoa in 1956. PAZIENZA was identified by her designer as 'a good example of a comfortable shorthanded cruising boat with a first-class performance under power yet able to take part successfully in ocean races'. An article in Yachting World in 1957, described PAZIENZA as follows: 'a large cutter into which a great deal of thought has been given to comfort and convenience'.

Previous owners, Martin and Vicky Jones, had taken her to the Caribbean in 2002. They sailed her back to the UK in 2003. In 2004, Richard and Judy were looking for a yacht to cross the Atlantic, and the search ended when they found PAZIENZA. Since that time Richard has realised his dream to cross the Atlantic twice, first in 2005 in the Atlantic Rally for Cruisers and again in 2008 in the Transat Classique Lagasse. On both occasions PAZIENZA has proved that she is an extremely sea worthy boat, taking care of all those who sail her. During their ownership PAZIENZA has undergone regular maintenance and upgrading of equipment and machinery.
