History

LYRA is the smallest and first of the Mayflowers, launched in 2009. Petite but perfectly in proportion she is a work of art, immaculately behaved and sails like a dream, inspiring immense confidence in her crew. On deck, her sunken cockpit makes for a secure helm position that Claude Worth would have been proud of.

Her interior is surprisingly spacious; 2 berths in the forepeak, a further 2 in the saloon and a separate heads allow privacy for guests aboard. Upon descending the companion way, her appearance is clean and unobstructed, that of a gentleman's day-sailor. Her saloon is beautifully finished in leather with contrasting cabinetry, which cleverly hides her galley. Handy, practical and stunning, LYRA is just the vessel, whether your plans are a weekend away or a brief, afternoon sail.
