History

FREYJA (KR115) is an International 8 Metre Cruiser Racer. She was designed in 1949 by Erling Kristofersen (who also developed the Knarr One Design) and built at the former Anker & Jensen yard in Asker, Norway in 1950.

FREYJA has had a series of Norwegian, German and Dutch owners, before we brought her to the UK in the summer of 2014. FREYJA benefited from an extensive refit in Holland in 2007.

Since arriving in the UK, we have been fortunate to have Ian Howlett redesign the keel and rudder, One Sails produce a full set of racing sails, Pauger replace the aluminium rig with carbon, and Steve Hulme keep her in tip-top condition.

All of which make her a joy to both cruise and race. FREYJA is moored in Emsworth.
