History

ONDINE OF IPSWICH was originally built in 2003/04 and commissioned as 'LITTLE FEAT' in Greece in 2004. There she was lightly used for cruising and occasional regattas until she was sold through Spirit Yachts to her second Owner in 2007. She remained in Greece and her name was changed to 'JIL'. Again, she was lightly used for family holidays by her Northern European owner until he asked Spirit yachts to broker her sale again. To achieve this, the yacht was returned to the Spirit Yard by truck and a sale was rapidly concluded.

She was re-named HELEN OF DURGAN by the next owner, and had a significant refit (June 2015) ready to re-launch as a UK resident yacht based in the Helford River. She was cruised widely round the UK, southern, northern and European coasts and actively competes in regattas.

Ken Smart became the new owner in 2021 and she has been re-named ONDINE OF IPSWICH.
