History

ROGUE is a classic Bermudan sloop designed by P.C. Crossley and built by Ponsharden Shipyard, Falmouth in 1934 for an Irish cricketer who lived close to the yard. Percy Crossley worked with the great Linton Hope, and was a notable member of the Royal Windermere Yacht Club for 60 years and the resident designer of the Windermere 17s

ROGUE is a typical yacht of the period with all the features we nowadays understand as a true classic yacht – elegant counter stern, full keel with cut-away fore foot, yacht-laid Kauri Pine deck and lots of varnished teak.

ROGUE has been fully restored over the few years by the current owner and is used regularly in the Solent, she is moored in Chichester Harbour.

ROGUE is a registered Historic Ship, number 2429.
